The 7th Army Training Command (ATC), U.S. Army, Europe, has accrued increasingly higher electrical utility bills over the past few years. As is true at most installations, the 7th ATC buildings are not equipped with electricity meters so it is difficult to identify the major power consumers. To determine electrical energy use patterns and potentially find energy conservation opportunities (ECOs), the 7th ATC asked the U.S. Army Construction Engineering Research Laboratory (USACERL) to study electricity consumption at two of its communities, Grafenwohr and Hohenfels, Federal Republic of Germany. Results of the predictive modeling and field testing showed several possible ECOs at Grafenwohr and Hohenfels, such as dimming exterior lights during some hours of the night, providing better controls on oversized ventilation systems in gymnasiums, and training dining hall personnel in energy-conservative practices. A major electrical power consumer is the training ranges; however, since the training mission has priority over energy use, little can be done at this time to reduce consumption there. In the future, target ranges may become available that provide the same quality of training with a lower energy demand.

This report was prepared in response to a request from the 7th Army Training Command. The purpose of the research reported here was to examine the impact of Skill Qualification Tests (SQT) training and testing on USAREUR units. Infantry battalions were chosen for the research because at the time of the research they were the first battalions in USAREUR to complete one SQT training/testing sequence for record in their high density MOS, 11B (infantryman) and 11C (indirect fire infantryman). All results presented below are for their initial SQT training/testing period.

This report presents the results of a task analysis of the performances required of a tank crew in accomplishing the revised Tank Crew Qualification Course set up by 7th Army Training Command at Crafenwoehr. This course was recently revised to increase the threat representation of the qualification course. As a first step in the development of such a program, an analysis of the performance requirements of the revised Table VIII was conducted. The critical characteristic of Table VIII is multi-target engagements. This firing table is defined by USAREUR Reg 350-704 (Draft of 10 May 1976 is the current basis of analysis). The training to be designed is to qualify crews on this table. Table VIII stresses both speed and accuracy of target engagement, but does not prescribe method (except for safety and minimal administrative requirements). It is thus a performance, rather than process specification.

In response to environmental concerns at the Combat Maneuver Training Center (CMTC), Hohenfels, Germany, the US Army 7th Army Training Command commissioned a scientific study by Argonne National Laboratory to investigate specific issues. The study involved three parts: (1) a field study to determine if fog oil and CS (a compound named after its discoverers, B.B. Carson and R.W. Stoughton) were accumulating in the CMTC environment, (2) a screening of selected soil samples for the presence of US Environmental Protection Agency priority pollutants, and (3) a literature review of the health effects of fog oil and CS, as well as a review of training practices at CMTC. No fog oil or fog oil degradation products were detected in any soil, sediment, or vegetation sample collected at CMTC. Trace quantities of one or more priority pollutants were tentatively detected in three of eight soil and sediment samples. However, the priority pollutant concentrations are so low that they pose no environmental or health hazards. No evidence of widespread or significant contamination in the training areas was found. Crucial data needed to fully evaluate both acute and chronic health effects of civilian exposures to CS at CMTC are not available. On the basis of the available literature, long-ten-n health effects in the civilian population near CMTC that could result from the use of fog oil and CS during training activities are believed to be negligible.
